- 2. Generosity Is Not An Obligation.
  - Giving under pressure isn't giving.

- Generosity is about the heart. Your heart is attached to your money.
- 3. Generosity Is A Response.
  - We give because God gave.

- > Spontaneous Giving: As the Lord leads.
- > Sacrificial giving: Isn't sacrificial until it hurts a little.
